#### **About our Speakers**

Sunday - Carrol Davenport, Hospice of Northeast Missouri's Spiritual Care & Bereavement Coordinator. Carrol will explore dealing with getting older and experiencing the reality of "life is NOT what I thought it would be when I got to this point." Many of us had lots of plans for those later years, but instead are dealing with physical issues that keep us from doing all the things we want to do. Join her as she talks through this new reality and what to do when life throws you a curve ball and you need to call on that internal resiliency that you didn't even know was there.

Sunday evening – Allison Barnard, MCAD is the Activity Director at Luther Manor in Hannibal, MO. She is currently the State Treasurer, Treasurer of North Missouri Chapter and the contact person for the Certification Committee. She will speak on the pathways available to become certified through ADAM.

Sunday evening – Delma Smith is the current ADAM State President, served previously for two terms and is President of the North Missouri Chapter. She has 37 years of experience in the long-term care field. She wants to see this organization build back to pre-Covid participation and involvement.

Monday - ADDC seminar pathway to eligibility to become a Certified Dementia Practitioner with NCCDP. Upon completion of this class, attendees can pursue the certification on their own at discounted 70.00 rate and will receive a letter to take and follow up with that rate instead of the 185.00 normal rate.
